Causes of WW1

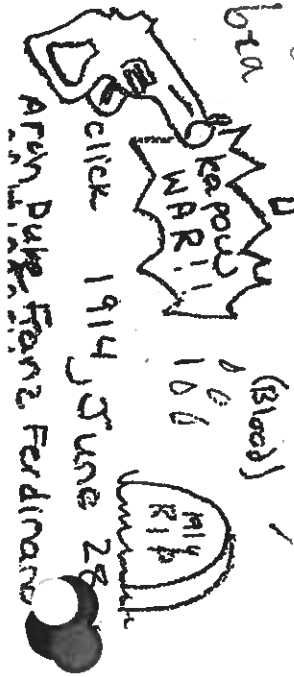
1 Imperialism: Fighting for resources

2 Militarism: when a country build their empire for war, Britain and Germany did this they wanted to use it.

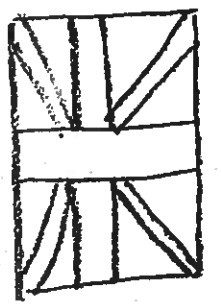
3 When countries / states pact to defend each other in case of an attack.

4 Nationalism: patriotism or belief that a country should be a single ethnicity

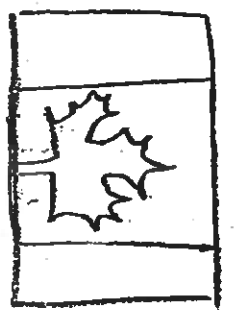
Trigger = GAV

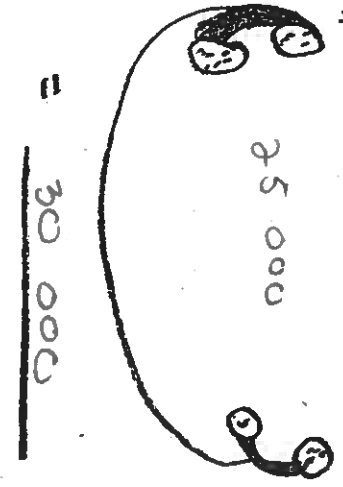
